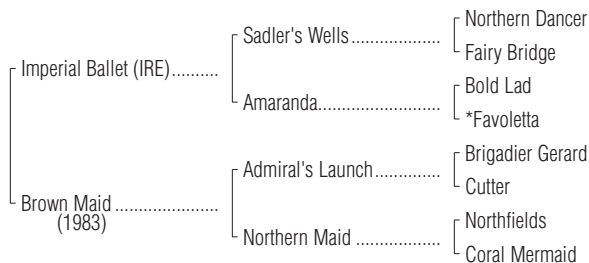

Sire of 7 crops of racing age, 133 foals, 82 starters, 39 winners of 77 races and earning \$574,507 in N.A./U.S., including Imperial Beauty (hwt. in Europe, Prix de l'Abbaye de Longchamp Majestic Barriere [G1], etc.), Grey Ballet (\$175,735, Lenta S. [L] (CRC, \$33,000), etc.), Shakira (Premio Estudio Hipica, etc.), Kurlicue (at 2, 2003, 3rd St. Bernard Blenheim S.), Joneta (to 4, 2003, \$43,891), Soaring Sky (\$38,004), Pont Aven (VEN) (\$33,868).

BROWN MAID, by Admiral's Launch. 3 wins at 2 and 3 in Uruguay, Gran Premio Bretana [G3], Premio Eugenio Lagarmilla; placed at 3 in Argentina, 2nd Premio Asociacion de Propietarios de Caballos de Carrera [G3], Premio Circulo de Propietarios de Caballerizas Sangre Pura de Carrera [G3], 3rd Premio Abril [G2], Premio Canada [G3], Premio General Las Heras [G3], 4th Premio Particula [G2]. Sister to **MOUNT ROYAL (URU)**, **BLONDE MAID**, **Redwood**, **Royal Runner**. Sent to Venezuela. Complete produce and race records not available. Dam of 6 known registered foals, 6 of racing age, 3 to race, 2 winners, including--
Supermaid (GB) (f. by Superlative). Placed at 2 in England; winner at 3, \$37,475, in N.A./U.S. Producer.

NORTHERN MAID, by Northfields. Winner at 4 in Ireland. Sent to Uruguay. Complete race records not available. Dam of 11 known winners, incl.--
MOUNT ROYAL (URU) (c. by Admiral's Launch). 6 wins in 9 starts at 2 and 3 in Uruguay, horse of the year, champion miler, Polla de Potrillos-Uruguay--an Two Thousand Guineas, Gran Premio Jockey Club, etc.; winner at 3 in Argentina, Gran Premio Joaquin S. de Anchorena-Internacional [G1], etc.
Other stakes winners: **MODERN MAID (URU)** [G1] (f. by Link (FR), champion 2-year-old filly in Uruguay), **BROWN MAID** (f. by Admiral's Launch, above), **BLONDE MAID** (f. by Admiral's Launch, Premio Diana [G2], etc.).

DANCE MASTER (1997), by Gone West--Nijinsky's Lover, by Nijinsky II. Stakes winner of 4 races at 2 and 3, \$196,455, Bashford Manor S. [G2], 2nd Anderson Fowler S. (MTH, \$8,550), 3rd Gilded Time S. [L] (GP, \$11,000). Half-brother to stakes winner Naninja. His first foals are 2-year-olds of 2004. Son of stakes winner Gone West, among the leading sires, sire of 68 stakes winners, including champions Zafonic (5 wins, Two Thousand Guineas [G1], etc.), Gone Prospecting.
